This term we are going to be covering the following topic:				
Science	Changing state – Children will explore how states of matter can change and will look at			
	both reversible and irreversible changes. They will explore the processes of the water cycle.			
Geography	Rio and South-East Brazil - Chn will learn how to locate South America on a world map			
	and identify some of its key features then compare these to the UK. They will also explore trade			
	links between countries.			
RE	Why do Christians call the day Jesus died 'Good Friday'? - Children will explore the			
	idea of salvation and the events of Holy Week as well as the relationship between humans			
	and God.			
	Islam – Children will explore Ramadan and the pilgrimage of Hajj.			
Collective	Compassion – We are exploring the value of compassion. Compassion is about having			
Worship	empathy with someone, it causes a desire to act to help others. In our school this can be seen			
	in the way children learn and play together.			
DT	Monster heads — Children will design and create monster heads, developing their			
	understanding of hydraulics and using design criteria to inform product choices.			
Computing	Internet safety – Children will explore how to keep our identity safe online. They will look			
	at digital footprints and how this information is used in scams and phishing.			
PE	Swimming - Children will develop their confidence in the water and begin to refine their			
	swimming strokes.			
PSHE	Healthy Me – Children will consider how they can make healthy choices in their lives			
	including through positive, supportive friendship, as well as understanding the effects of			
	smoking and alcohol on the body.
