**This term we are going to be covering the following topic:**

<b>Science</b>	<b>Living Things and their Habitats</b> - Pupils will learn what a habitat is, the difference between a habitat and microhabitat and how animals and plants depend on each other.
<b>PSHE</b>	<b>Relationships</b> - To know how to make friends, solve problems, show respect, help others and know how to make strong relationships.
<b>RE</b>	<b>Multicultural Christianity</b> - Talk and think about the first Christians and the spread of Christianity and to give the children a simple introduction to understanding Christianity as a Multi-cultural and worldwide faith. Sikhism-Festivals
<b>Geography</b>	<b>United Kingdom</b> - Children will learn to name and locate the four countries of the United Kingdom and identify the four capital cities and surrounding seas of the United Kingdom. They will explain the differences between human and physical features and describe the human and physical features of one of the UK's capital cities.
<b>PE</b>	<b>Swimming</b> – Learning how to swim and how we can be safe near and in the water.
<b>Music</b>	<b>Having fun with improvisation</b> – Pupils will enjoy a range of musical games, songs and instruments and improvise around a range of songs in the Charanga Scheme.
<b>Computing</b>	<b>Maze Explorers</b> – Pupils will engage in a series of challenges where they create algorithms and use directional keys to navigate their way through different maze challenges.
<b>DT</b>	<b>Moving Vehicles</b> -Pupils will learn to explore the features of a range of vehicles then design, model and evaluate their own vehicles.
