Science	circuits and o	Children are exploring electricity this half term; they will be given opportunities to create and build circuits and draw diagrams using symbols related to electrical circuits. They will understand how electrical currents work and explain how each component works.						
History	how women faced. Childr	This half term children are exploring the changing role of women throughout history. They will learn how women have been discriminated against and will come to understand gender stereotypes women faced. Children will also examine the rise of key political movements such as the suffragettes and analyse the life of Emmeline Pankhurst.
