**Write** your own story or **draw** your own comic strip inspired by this image:

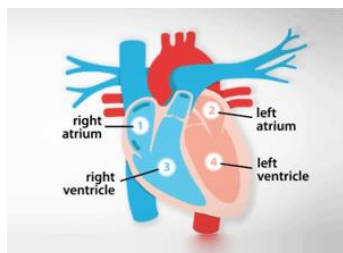


In D.T, we will design and create our own **minestrone soups**.
