This term we are going to be covering the following topic:	
Science	States of matter - Children will investigate the properties of solids, liquids and gases. They will also develop their exploration of particle structure and movement.
History	Romans - Invaders and Settlers - Children will explore the invasion and settlements of Romans in Britain. They will also research life in Roman Britain and key historical figures.
RE	The Church - Children will explore places of worship from around the world and consider similarities and differences across religious communities.
Collective Worship	Joy - Children will explore joy as a feeling of content that comes from having faith in God, even in chaos and difficulties.
Art	Jewellery designers - Children will explore jewellery of the past and present, then will use this inspiration to design and create their own products.
Computing	Online safety and communication - Children will learn to identify potential dangers on-line and know how to protect their personal information on-line.
PE	Swimming - Children will develop their water confidence and range of strokes in the water, as well as revisiting water safety skills.
PSHE	Financial education - Children will explore financial terminology and start to develop an understanding of how to form good money management and budgeting skills.
